



## UNIVERSAL EDUCATION SPORTS SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

Universal Education through its, '**Sports Scholarship Program**', offers the opportunity to meritorious students to be a part of a learning environment that appreciates sportive talent.

Eligibility criteria for the Sports Scholarship is as under:

- a) New students seeking admission are eligible to apply for the Sports Scholarship based on the sportive achievements in AY 2019 – 20.
- b) Existing students of Universal Education are eligible on the basis of sportive achievements in AY 2020 – 21.
- c) To qualify for this scholarship, student should have participated in an Internationally recognized sporting event at International, National, State or District level and won Gold, Silver or Bronze medal.

The selection will be at the sole discretion of the Management.

The scholarship is valid for one year only.

Renewal / Modification in the criteria is subject to winning medal in the subsequent year. Students have the opportunity to improve their performance and become eligible for a higher percentage of scholarship in the subsequent year and in the case of drop in performance will also drop down in the category of scholarship. No two categories can be clubbed together.

### **General regulations governing the scholarship policy:**

- a) All decisions of selection of students for scholarship are at the discretion of the management and any representation refuting the decision of the management will not be accepted.
- b) Intimation of scholarship will be made in writing signed by the management representative. No oral confirmation should be considered.
- c) Scholarship amount is strictly restricted/calculated only on the tuition fee and all other applicable fees are payable by the student.
- d) The management at any time may withdraw the scholarship offered without giving any notice.
